- All Band and Individual Piping entries must be postmarked or received by (04/01/2010). Field entries will be accepted for Drumming events and maybe charged an additional fee. Advance entries include admission tickets.
- If not registering online, mail in entries and **include a stamped self-addressed legal-size envelope and check(s)** made out to '**CSSM**' to:

- Print, sign, and bring 'Hold Harmless Agreement' to the event.
- Tickets will be mailed to competitors prior to the competition if registering by mail. Upon completion of online registration you will be able to print your ticket.
- All competitors, except for Grade V, must wear suitable Highland attire.
- Band representatives meeting and draw for order of play will be held at 10:00 am.
- A travel allowance for bands will be paid based on mileage. To receive the travel allowance, bands must compete and participate in all massed bands.
- Medals will be awarded in individual piping and drumming events. Cash prizes will be awarded in all Professional events.
- Bands will receive trophies for 1st place plus cash prizes for 1st through 3rd place.
- EUSPBA rules will apply. Decisions by judges, stewards and the Piping and Drumming Committee are final. CSSM reserves the right to cancel any event for which insufficient entries are received.
- CSSM will have directions posted on their websites and will be included in acknowledgement letters. Checks must be made payable to the CSSM. Competitions are all held on Saturday.
